Winter Skeet League

Peoria Skeet and Trap Club

We plan to make this event fun for all and will **shoot on Sundays** (**or Saturdays**) beginning at 11:00 am until complete (no later than 2:30 pm). You may shoot once all your team has arrived and a field and scorer is available. A shooter can shoot on as many teams as they like.

LEAGUE: The league will consist of as many teams as possible and will begin in late January (specific date to be determined) and run for 8 weeks. Members of each team will shoot **two rounds** of skeet (50 targets) **each week**.

HANDICAP: Each team will have an average based on total targets (sum of all targets broken divided by 3 shooters x 50 targets). For a handicap, the difference between the averages of each team is calculated then 75% of this difference is added to the total of the lower averaged team. Example: Team 1 has an average of 118. Team 2 has an average of 147. Thus 147 - 118 = 29 and 75% of 29 = 22 which is added to the score of team 1 to provide them a handicap.

SPONSORSHIP: There is no sponsorship required for this league.

TEAMS: Teams will be <u>made up of 3 members</u>. Each member will shoot every week unless they have shot a bank (see BANKS). It is acceptable to have alternates on your team if you would like.

TEAM CAPTAIN: Each team should have a Team Captain. It is the Team Captain's responsibility to collect the league fees (\$14) and to return completed score sheet(s) to the Club House immediately after your team has shot.

FEES: Fees are \$14 per person per week

START TIME: League shooting can start at 11:00 am (normal club opening time). If possible, please try to give some indication to the Club Manager ahead of time on approximately when your team might shoot. This will help with insuring scorers will be available.

BANKS: Each member will be required to shoot each week. In the event a member is unable to be present on a shoot day (Sat/Sun), they may make a request to use their bank score. A bank score is a score that has been shot in advance by any person who may be absent. The shooter should make a request at the counter to "shoot a bank". Once they have shot a bank with a scorer, they will complete a bank form by indicating the score shot, signing it and having the counter person sign as well. This bank will be held by the counter and will be used on the first absence of the shooter. Shooters may shoot as many banks as needed. Any shooter who does not shoot on League day (Sat/Sun) and does not have a bank in place will have their current average used minus 2 birds. Team members who miss the first week can make up that score on the second week.
